IMC:

- They received a cargo in Beirut. Will be transported by the logistics cluster. Still waiting for CMR.
- They were interested to gather information as the new logistics manager arrived in Lebanon couple days ago.

HWA:

- Placed a CMR through Beirut on the 15th of September (400 mixed food parcel) we will take care of the warehousing then probably assist them in term of transport.
