

# NFI & ES Sector Monthly Update #2

**DARFUR**  
February 2008

## Executive Summary

A total of 44,964 households received non-food and emergency shelter items from the Common Pipeline, of which 65% were IDPs requiring replenishment.

## Sector Overview

### Funding Update

The first 2008 CHF allocations that were made in January have now been released to NGOs. The NGOs have been instructed to begin the process of receiving these funds by filing the needed paperwork with the UNDP fund management in Khartoum.

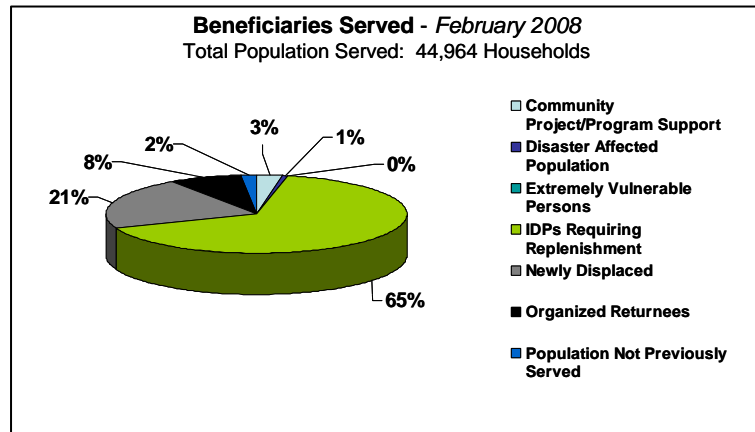

## NFI Common Pipeline

### February Activities

During the month, 44,964 households were served with non-food items from the Common Pipeline in Darfur, of which approximately 35,328 were IDPs requiring replenishment. The largest distributions were by SUDO in Northern Darfur targeting over 13,000 households, by OXFAM targeting over 7,000 households in the areas of North Darfur, and by Triangle, which completed distribution of items to approximately 7,200 households in Southern Darfur. Of the beneficiaries served, approximately 52% were in North Darfur, 22% were in South Darfur and 26% were in West Darfur. Blankets and sleeping mats were the two most-distributed items with 83,273 pieces and 80,328 pieces provided, respectively.
